



## THE EUROPEAN IM-FUTURE PROJECT PRESENTS ITS FINAL RESULTS



### ***The International Master's Degree in the Furniture Sector was shown to representatives from the furniture and woodworking industry Higher Education and employment***

IM-FUTURE, the International Master's Degree in the Furniture Sector has achieved its objectives and is completely finished. The European project was presented in one event held in Spain in order to release and explain the main features of this exclusive Master. The presentation took place in CETEM's facilities in April where representatives from the furniture and woodworking industry, Higher Education, employment, as well as students and other stakeholders were invited.

The International Master's Degree for the furniture sector is a flexible learning pathway totally aligned with the needs of the furniture, woodworking and related sectors. The attendants were given the opportunity to discover all the work performed and the final results, where they were showed the IM-FUTURE training platform.

The developed curriculum, which is available on a training platform, is attuned to current labour market needs of the sector and will provide opportunities for students to gain additional skills through study and training abroad. This will attract people into Higher Education and will increase employment rates of the sector.

As an open-learning source, both students, training institutions and industry can take up the whole training offer or even adapt it to its needs due to its flexible structure. The students of this International Master's Degree can choose 5 different specializations: Production, Business, Design, Research and General Master which are composed by modules; some of them as compulsory and

others as optional ones, Practices and Dissertation.

The developed training material is cofounded by the Erasmus + programme of the European Union. IM-FUTURE is a European project (2016-1-UK01-KA203-024438) which arises from a Strategic partnership composed of seven entities from regions that are highly influenced by the furniture and woodworking industry: Four universities, two technical research and training centres and one furniture industry representatives from the UK, Italy, Poland and Spain.
